



## Wellington company, pattillo, is offering the scholarship for developing artists and has given a commitment to fund the scholarship for the next ten years.

The scholarship is for \$7,500 each year and is intended to be used for further studies in the arts. It may be used for course fees at the Quay School of Art.

pattillo specialises in organisational leadership – the transformation of ideas is a big part of who they are. The company defines itself as sculpting the rich source of creativity in chaos.

commission a new sculptural piece from a Quay School of Art student each year which will become an integral part of its identity. pattillo has chosen to confer the scholarship on Quay School of Arts students because of the school's increasing reputation nationally and internationally – and to celebrate Wanganui's long history of artistic interest and commitment.

pattillo's commitment to students is to create a network of people who are exploring the world through art and to encourage exploration of working with what is – which is the essence of what pattillo does.

Students wishing to apply for the scholarship are invited to submit a sculptural piece reflective of "sculpting chaos". As chaos is a naturally occurring form, materials used must be found in nature.

Entries will be judged by a jury made up of representatives of the Quay School of Art, pattillo and the Arts community.
